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### ■ **FORMAT OF QUESTION PAPER**

- ✓ There will be one paper (theoretical) of two hours duration carrying 80 marks and internal assessment (two projects) of 10 marks each.
- ✓ The theory paper will be divided into two parts /sections.

**SECTION A (40 marks)**: will consist of questions requiring short answers and will cover the entire syllabus. There will be no choice of questions. Each question will carry **two** marks.
