The Legacy of Blessed Edmund Rice

BLESSED EDMUND RICE WAS BORN IN IRELAND IN 1762. HE WAS A SUCCESSFUL BUSINESSMAN, BUT AFTER THE TRAGIC LOSS OF HIS WIFE, HE DEDICATED HIS LIFE TO HELPING THE POOR. HE SAW THAT MANY CHILDREN IN HIS SOCIETY HAD NO ACCESS TO EDUCATION. MOVED BY COMPASSION, HE SOLD HIS BUSINESS AND BEGAN TEACHING POOR BOYS. IN 1802, HE OPENED HIS FIRST SCHOOL IN WATERFORD. SOON, LIKE-MINDED MEN JOINED HIM, AND TOGETHER, THEY FORMED THE CONGREGATION OF CHRISTIAN BROTHERS. TODAY, HIS MISSION CONTINUES ACROSS THE WORLD, INCLUDING AT ST. JOSEPH'S COLLEGE, KOLKATA.

STUDENTS NEED TO BECOME ACTIVE PARTICIPANTS IN THE LEARNING PROCESS AND TO THIS END CERTAIN STRATEGIES HAVE STUDENTS CONTRIBUTE TO INPUTS E.G. THE THINK-PAIR-SHARE SYSTEM HAS BEEN INTRODUCED INTO THE SCHOOL.
